

## WYSIWYG Editors

### Demo (editor)

- Create an article.
  - what are text formats?

### TEXT FORMATS (admin)

Administration » Configuration » Content authoring » Text formats

- Create a new format called "WYSIWYG"
- assign it to the roles of people you want to use it: "editor"
- decide which filters you want to run on your content.
- configure filters

### Demo (editor)

- edit existing content
- show new option in drop-down

### WYSIWYG editor (admin)

Administration » Modules

- Enable the WYSIWYG module

Administration » Configuration » Content authoring » Wysiwyg Profiles

- Download & Install WYSIWYG editor of your choice
  - choose the editor you like from the list
  - download via download link provided
  - unzip files and move into libraries directory
  - refresh the page
- Assign an editor to WYSIWYG formats
- Configure WYSIWYG profile
  - uncheck disable / enable link
  - add a \*few\* buttons / plugins
    - bold, italic, bullet list, number list, source code, etc
  - check apply source formatting
  - check Force cleanup on standard paste
  - save

## CLEANUP (admin)

Administration » Modules

- Enable the Better Formats module

## Explain (admin)

- Permissions govern who gets help.
- Also: per-field defaults (needs core patch)

## WYSIWYG Images

Administration » Modules

- Enable the IMCE module AND the IMCE WYSIWYG API bridge module

Administration » Configuration » Media » IMCE

- IMCE settings
  - assign 'sample profile' to 'editor' role
  - set up a files directory for this profile
    - enter the directory for icons (images/icons)
    - allow browse, upload, and thumbs

Administration » Configuration » Content authoring

- Add Image Button and IMCE plugin for WYSIWYG profiles
  - under 'Buttons and Plugins'
    - check Image button box
    - check IMCE plugin box

## Demo (editor)

- Use the image button in wysiwyg to an image from anywhere on the internet
  - a struggle!

## DRUAPL FILES (admin)

Administration » Modules

- Enable Insert module

Administration » Structure » Content types » Basic page

- configure Basic page content type.
  - expand the fieldset for "Insert"

- check the box to allow
- select which image styles are also allowed
  - (uncheck Automatic)

#### Demo (editor)

- Create a Basic page
  - upload a file, provide alt text, click insert.
- Pop Quiz: what went wrong?

#### Fix (admin)

Administration » Configuration » Content authoring » Text formats » WYSIWYG

- Edit text format to allow IMG tag

#### CSS (admin)

Administration » Configuration » Content authoring » Wysiwyg profiles »

#### WYSIWYGS

- Add a new plugin: Font Style
- Update CSS settings:
  - Editor css: define
  - CSS path: /sites/wysiwyg.dev/themes/wysiwyg\_theme/wysiwyg.css
  - CSS classes:
    - Align image left=image-left
    - Align image right=image-right

- Edit basic page, apply a class.

#### Captions (admin)

Administration » Modules

- Enable caption filter module

Administration » Structure » Content types » Basic page

- Configure inline image field
  - enable the use of title field
  - enable use of title field as caption
- Add the caption filter to your text format
- Add the caption filter plugin to your WYSIWYG profile

## Demo (editor)

- Edit page, insert w/ caption
  - click left + right

## Image Sources (admin)

Administration » Modules

- Enable Sources module

Administration » Structure » Content types » Basic page

- Configure inline image field
  - File sources: enable all sources
  - File Attach settings: images/icons

## (IF THERES TIME) CHANGE SIZES (admin)

Administration » Modules

- Enable Image Resize Filter module
- Add the new Filter to the WYSIWYG text format

## Demo (editor)

- Resize the image in the text area.
  - save the page.
  - view the image - check the path.

## (IF THERES TIME) WYSIWYG CSS:

### WYSIWYG filter (admin)

Administration » Modules

- Enable wysiwyg\_filter module
- Edit WYSIWYG text format
  - disable Drupal's core HTML filter
  - enable WYSIWYG filter
    - configure WYSIWYG filters:
      - remove HTML tags you want removed

- ad back HTML tags you want added
- add class names you want allowed:  
image-right, image-left
